



# INLAND WATERWAYS COURSES



Learn to handle a narrowboat or cruiser on canals and rivers. With courses for beginners and more experienced boaters, RYA training will give you the confidence and skills to explore the waterways. The Helmsman's Certificate can be used in addition to a CEVNI test certificate to apply for the International Certificate of Competence, which is commonly required for cruising the inland waterways of Europe.

<b>Helmsman's Course</b>	None	Safety, helmsmanship, lock operations, collision avoidance, engine checks	Able to helm a vessel safely on inland waterways	2 days	12
