FOREWORD

As the 2012 Olympic Games really comes into focus, 2011 will see the Olympic Trials as the key focus for most sailors this year. Skandia Sail for Gold regatta is a key part of this process for GBR and many other countries, which will ensure that it is the toughest of challenges on the journey to the 2012 Games. Subsequently, this regatta is sure to become a watershed moment for many, as everyone looks to deliver their best performances in June this year. Some will be pleased that they are on target to achieve their goals, while others will be left wanting. For all of us however, we will know that the process of a tough GBR selection year is key to a good team performance at the Games in 2012.

As we progress through the year the overall philosophy of the World Class Programme will be to increase the level of support for our potential Olympians while ensuring we do not miss the opportunity for our Development Squad sailors to learn from the trials experience. We will continue to focus on developing a greater understanding of the London 2012 sailing areas and ensuring we can maximize the home advantage the 2012 Games will bring.

All WCP Squad members continue to benefit from the RYA user agreement with WPNSA which allows free access, including a dinghy park space and harbour dues. The RYA National Ranking Series, including the Sail for Gold Regatta, will also continue to be based at the WPNSA. This series is compulsory for all sailors on the World Class Programme.

In 2010 the RYA Olympic Classes National Ranking Series will consist of the following events at WPNSA for all classes except the Laser and Radial who will use the regattas outlined in their class page in this booklet;

5th-11th June, Skandia Sail for Gold Regatta, ~ 17th /18th September, National Ranker, WPNSA
~ 15th/16th October, National Ranker, WPNSA

The RYA Olympic Classes Spring Series will continue to form part of the grant and places Qualification Series for International events and will remain compulsory for sailors on the World Class Olympic Development Programme. The key dates are as follows;

12th /13th March, WPNSA ~ 14th /15th May, HISC

The Notice of Race (NOR) for the above early season events can be found on page 32 in this booklet and this and the NOR for the National Ranking Series will be posted on the Skandia Team GBR website.

Included in this handbook are class programmes and guidelines for:

- All Olympic class competition programmes
- All Olympic class event selection procedures
- All Olympic class grant eligibility
- Entry criteria to World Class Squad programme

The version found on the Skandia Team GBR website will be kept up to date and therefore subject to relevant revisions.

Grants are available to sailors not on the World Class Development Squad (ODS) and Performance programmes to help them attend major championships and important International events. Olympic Transitional sailors are eligible for these grants.

Sailors aspiring to the ODS or the WCP squads should refer to the pages outlining the eligibility criteria. It should be noted that these are criteria for consideration for selection and that simply achieving the criteria will not automatically ensure a squad place. If you have any questions regarding your eligibility, in the first instance, contact the ODS Manager.

2010 was Skandia Team GBR's most successful year ever in terms of total medals won; however I am confident that 2011 will be even better as we look to turn more of those medals into gold/

The RYA Racing Charter



Objectives

To provide the framework for everyone to enjoy the sport of sailboat racing in whatever capacity and to whatever level the individual desires.

To ensure that the sport of sailboat racing welcomes people and treats them equally.

To ensure that those who experience sailboat racing are encouraged to continue.

Principles and Practices

The sport welcomes all participants; it relies largely on self-compliance and self-policing. Those that deliberately take unfair advantage of this or behave in an inappropriate manner, either on or off the water, can expect to be brought to account.

Competitors agree to compete and behave in compliance with the rules and in accordance with accepted standards of sailboat racing. When involved in a genuine dispute, both the parties to the dispute and those deciding the matter will use the established procedures for achieving resolution.

Foul or abusive language, intimidation, aggressive behavior or lack of respect for others and their property will not be tolerated.

Organizers, officials and other providers of sailboat racing agree to strive to provide the fairest racing possible. This includes encouraging feed-back and facilitating the resolution of genuine disputes (including protests) in a timely and proper manner.

Coaches and other advisors agree to encourage their charges to compete, officiate or behave only in compliance with the above principles and practices.

This Charter applies equally to those who organize, manage, coach, advise, judge, provide services and compete (including those who support competitors) in sailboat racing.

The RYA encourages the adoption and implementation of this Charter, and provides guidance and support to individuals and organizations to assist implementation. This guidance and support is consistent with the practices of the International Sailing Federation.

Application of RYA Racing Charter

Through its Racing Charter, the RYA seeks to promote fair and enjoyable racing for all.

Competitors who sail under the Charter should expect:

- to be provided with racing that, as far as is possible, is fair, enjoyable and safe;
- to receive services that conform to those guidelines endorsed by the RYA and appropriate to the event;
- to be able to inform Organizing Authorities when any racing services are not provided to acceptable standards;
- to be provided with prompt services to resolve any disputes.

Competitors who sail under the Charter are expected:

- to show courtesy and respect to other competitors and officials, and to other users of the water;
- to compete in compliance with the rules, and take a penalty when required by the rules;
- to use the provided services to resolve any disputes.

Rule 69 is used by the sport of sailboat racing to control and penalize unacceptable behaviour at an event. Guidelines on its application in the UK follow.

Notes:

- To be eligible for consideration for selection to the WCPP sailors must have a realistic chance of winning a medal in a major international competition within 6 years in addition to meeting the performance criteria
 - Performance criteria are minimum requirements to be considered for selection to the WCPP – simply achieving the criteria will not automatically result in a squad place
 - Results are sailors' (not nations') and European Championship results exclude non-Europeans
 - Performance level C – Top 20% of the fleet entry with no finishing position greater than 20th at the World Championships (15th for the Europeans) when the fleet entry is greater than 100 boats (75 for the Europeans)
 - The length of time a sailor remains at a level will be **continually reviewed**, however, as a guideline, sailors are expected to re-qualify as a minimum as follows:
 - Level A – at one of the next two World Championships (or appropriate Olympics/Pre-Olympics)
 - Levels B & C – at either the next World or European Championship (or appropriate Olympics/Pre-Olympics)
- Crews that split up or change class but are invited to remain on the programme will normally drop one level

Guidelines and Criteria for Eligibility

The following is a guide to help you establish whether you could be considered for inclusion in the Olympic Development Squad (ODS).

Selection to the squad is judged on results and subjective criteria as follows:

1. Medal at ISAF or Class Youth World Championships
2. Significant results at major Olympic Class regattas - Hyeres, Spa, Kiel, World and European Championships (as assessed by the ODS Manager)
3. Attained specific performance standards (as assessed by ODS Manager)
4. Correct physique for chosen class
5. Commitment, personal goals and aspirations
6. Age

Additional factors to consider:

- National rankings results may be used but international results will normally take precedence
- Additions and deletions from the ODS program are decided by the Olympic Steering Group (OSG)

Above are the guidelines. To see how these may be applied please see below a few examples of imaginary individuals:

Example 1:- A Youth Worlds medalist who fits the correct physique for chosen Olympic class would be considered.

Example 2:- A Youth Worlds medalist who is incorrect physical size for chosen Olympic Class would probably not be considered for that class but may be considered for another more suitable Olympic Class.

Example 3:- A 25 year old sailor who has been in an Olympic class since post youth age would be unlikely to be considered for ODS. This individual would be expected to achieve UK Sport's performance criteria for consideration for the World Class Performance Programme.

Example 4:- A sailor who moves from a non Olympic class to an Olympic class and achieves significant results, maybe considered.

It should be noted that these are criteria for consideration for selection and that simply achieving the criteria will not automatically ensure a squad place.

SKANDIA TEAM GBR TRANSITIONAL SAILOR

When sailors fulfill some but not all of the ODS criteria they may receive Transitional support at the sole discretion of the Olympic Steering Group as assessed by the ODS Manager. Transitional support will be offered and reviewed on a case by case basis in keeping with the goals of the sailing World Class Programme.

Paralympic Programme

Whilst the general policy's, guidelines and criteria for eligibility outlined in this booklet cover all Skandia Team GBR Olympic and Paralympic Classes, both the pathway and eligibility (Classification) does set it apart in some aspects from the Olympic Classes.

Paralympic Guidelines and Criteria For Eligibility

The Following is a guide to help you establish whether you could be considered for inclusion in the Olympic Development Programme:

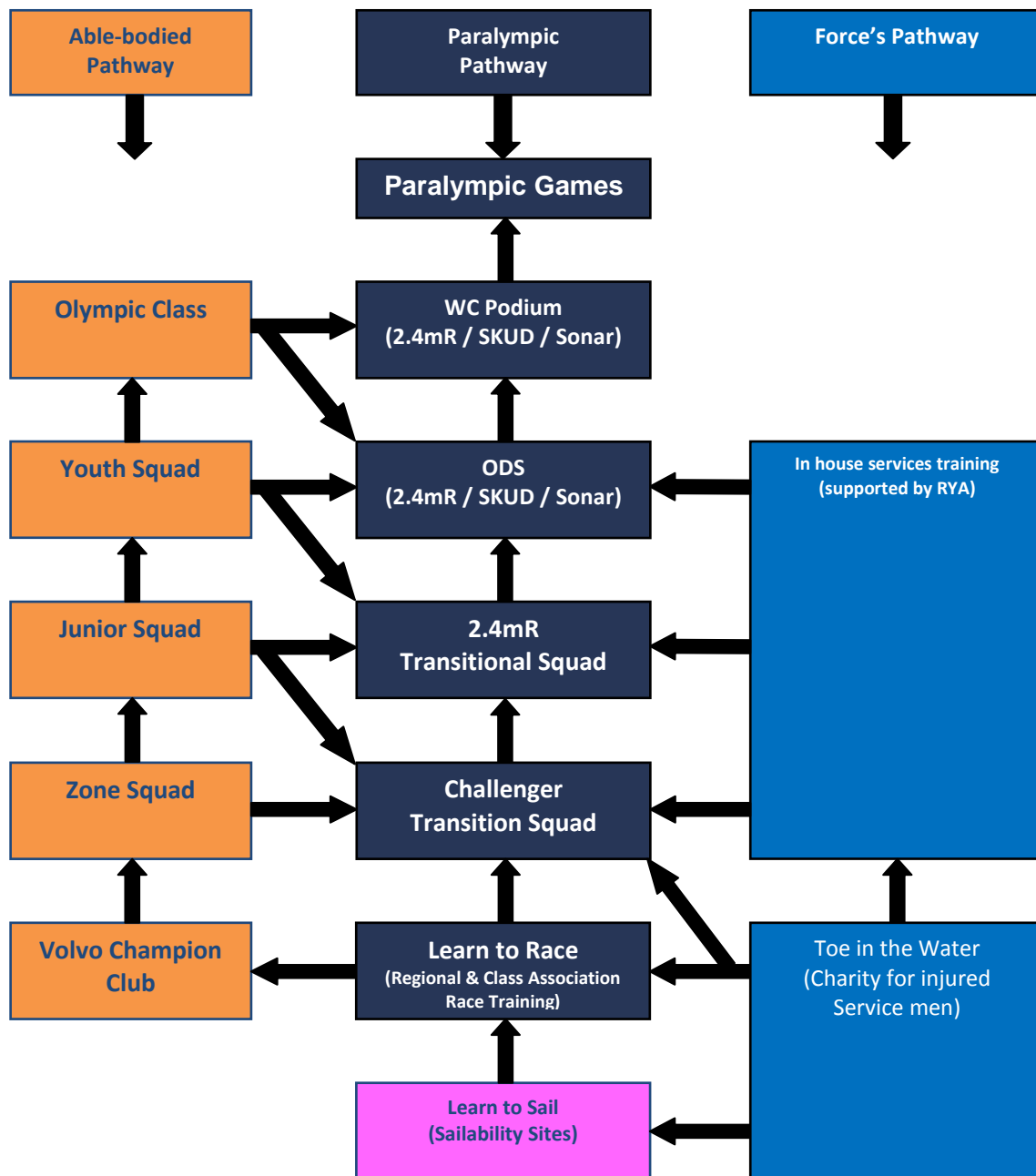
- Attained specific performance standards (as assessed by ODS Manager)
- Medal winning potential
- Correct disability and physique for chosen class (see below)
- Commitment, personal goals and aspirations
- Age

Only sailors qualifying under IFDS (international Federation of Disabled Sailing) Functional Classification rules are eligible to compete at Paralympic level. In brief a sailor has their functionality assessed in a boat and is awarded an FC number depending purely on functionality. For a detailed account of this process, please use this link

RYA Grants System

The RYA provides a limited amount of grant support to non WC Development and Performance Squad sailors to help them attend major championships and important Eurolymp events. WC Olympic Transitional Sailors are also eligible for these travel grants. The grant is approximately the traveling costs, based on double or triple trailing, calculated by the RYA.

The Grant amounts are dependant upon the RYA Exchequer award and are normally paid one month prior to the event. All grants are repayable immediately if the sailor does not attend the regatta for any reason. Grants will not be handed down in the event of the grant winner not attending the event.

Grant recipients are subject to an RYA code of conduct which must be signed and returned before payment will be made.

The qualification system for all of the available grants are shown in this booklet under each class programme.

Notice of Race

This Notice of Race refers to the following events and replaces any past notices:
WPNSA 12th & 13th March and HISC 14th & 15th May.

1. Organising Authority

The Organising Authority shall be the RYA and the host sailing club.

2. Rules

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

3. Classes

Racing at one or both events will be in the following classes: Sonar, SKUD, 470, Finn, 2.4mR, 49er and NP RSX 9.5 men and 8.5 open. Information regarding which classes will be competing can be found in the RYA Olympic Classes Fixture Booklet, which is updated on the Skandia Team GBR website.

4. Advertising

In accordance with ISAF rule 20.3 (d) (i) and (ii) in Appendix 1, boats and boards shall display, at all times, a sticker with the event sponsor advertising when provided at registration.

5. Eligibility & Entries

Entries for the WPNSA event, should be made online via www.ryaracingevents.org.uk no later than 7th March. Late entries will incur a 50% entry fee penalty. Entry for the 14/15th May, HISC event, shall be made at registration. Three class entries are required for racing to take place for that class.

Only competitors eligible to sail for GBR may enter the WPNSA event unless non GBR competitors are granted permission to race by the RYA.

All sailors under 18 years of age must produce a completed parent/guardian consent form available on the RYA Events website. Without a completed form, sailors under the age of 18 will not be allowed to register.

6. Registration

Registration will take place at the race office no later than 0900 on Saturday.

7. Races

The first race on the first scheduled day of racing is scheduled to start at 1200.

8. Scoring

The RYA Olympic Classes Spring Series Winner will be scored on the total points of the overall finishing position at both events added together. Where 470 men and women classes start together, individual race results will be calculated using the finishing positions of the combined fleet to decide men and womens results. The same applies for RSX 9.5 and 8.5 classes.

9. Certificates

All competing boats should hold a valid measurement certificate, which may be required to be shown at registration.

10. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions and Local Instructions will be available at registration.

11. Safety

10.1 A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else reduces this responsibility.

10.2 It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

10.3 Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.

10.4 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.

10.5 Each boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000.

12. Obligations

All sailors on the Skandia Team GBR Development Programmes are required to attend all RYA Spring Series Events where their class is included.
