WHAT'S ON OFFER?

Which universities have a sailing club?

Aberdeen, Aberystwyth, Bath, Birmingham, Bristol, Brunel, Cambridge, Cardiff, Coventry, Dundee, Durham, East Anglia, Edinburgh, Exeter, Glasgow, Imperial, Lancaster, Leeds, Liverpool, London, Loughborough, Manchester, Newcastle, Nottingham, Oxford, Plymouth, Portsmouth, Reading, Robert Gordon, Sheffield, Sheffield Hallam, Southampton, Southampton Solent, St Andrews, Strathclyde, Surrey, Swansea, Warwick, West of England, York.

What type of sailing can I do at University?

Fleet Racing – Nationals and Inlands each year, either bring your own boat or sail a club boat (firefly/laser 2).

Team Racing – 6 people to a team in 3 boats, sailing against another 6 people in 3 boats.

Match Racing – Teams of 3-5 sailors racing in a small keelboat (Sonar/J80) in a one on one battle to cross the line first.

Yachting – Nationals championships held annually in the Sunsail 37s. 8 crew on board, last event of the season!
