INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE RENEWAL

According to our records your International Certificate of Competence is due for renewal. A renewal form is on the reverse of this letter for you to use if you wish to renew it. This certificate is available only to British Citizens or bone fide British Residents. (If you are not a British Citizen evidence of British residency **will** be required).

If you have a certificate for an auxiliary sailing yacht we can issue an ICC valid for both sail and power. This acknowledges the fact that RYA cruising courses and the ICC test include an assessment under power as well as sail.

For inland certificates a test on CEVNI is required. This is a short multiple choice test, which can be taken at any RYA practical Training Centre. A list of test centres can be found on the RYA website, www.rya.org.uk.

If you wish to renew your ICC then please complete and return the form on the reverse of this letter and send your old certificate (if possible) together with a passport-sized photograph ensuring you print your name on the back of the photo. If you require a certificate valid for Inland Waters please make sure you have passed a CEVNI test.

PLEASE NOTE:- No certificates are required on UK inland or coastal waters for pleasure vessels under 80 registered tons or under 24m in length unless they are used for commercial purposes. CEVNI is not used on UK inland waters. This certificate is available **ONLY** to **BRITISH CITIZENS** or bone fide British Residents. (Evidence of British residency may be required). **P.T.O.**
