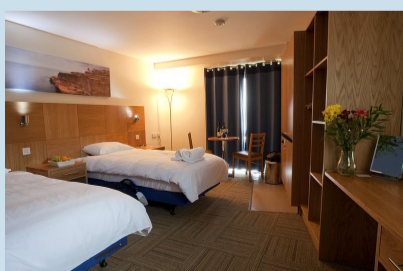

## RYA YOUTH MATCH RACING 2010

Match Racing is starting to take bigger role in Olympic sailing, it is also a fun and different way to learn tactics for fleet racing plus it helps you with team work as well.



The RYA are running the Match Racing Youth Championships at Weymouth and Portland on 28th and 29th August.

This is an ideal first event for budding match racers and great fun.

Why not enter and give it a go?

- ♣ You need to be under 25 to enter the Youth Match Racing
- ♣ Crews consist of 3 to 5 people and it is best for the combined weight of the crew to be as near to the maximum as possible
- ♣ Usually one person helms, another does the mainsheet and tactics, another does the jib and the spinnaker—if you have more than 3 people you can split up the roles even further
