The completed application form must be sent to the RYA with:

- A passport size photo with your name printed on the back
- RYA membership number or the ICC fee (see application form for current fees)
- Evidence of competence (see below)

The minimum age for ICC applicants is 16.

As evidence of competence one of the following must be provided:

Either:

- Copy of an existing certificate

Or:

- Completed section 11b on the application form following a practical ICC test at a Club or Recognised Training Centre.

For applicants requiring an ICC for inland waters, please ensure that section 11c is completed following successful completion of a CEVNI test.
