

RACING COACH COURSE SET UP



What is the process?

What support can the RYA offer?

3 + months prior to the start of the course.

HPM/RDO visits Club and highlights need for RCL2 to support club race training.

- Highlights benefit of club volunteers gaining RYA coaching qualification.
- Discussion on various ways to set up a course.
- RYA can point clubs/candidates in the direction of local funding to assist with costs.

3 months prior to the start of the course.

Course agreed between Club and RYA.
RYA HQ informed and sets up course with candidates able to apply and pay online.

- Discussions with your HPM/RDO.
- RYA HQ will find a tutor to deliver the course on agreed dates.
- All admin covered by RYA HQ.

12-6 weeks prior to the start of the course.

HPM approves applications. Candidates complete pre-coursework.
If a "member's only" course has spaces it is opened up to the public with 6 weeks to go.

- Feedback provided to those not accepted onto the course.
- RYA will help to advertise the course through a variety of RYA publications.

4 weeks prior to the start of the course.

If there is not the minimum amount of candidates on the course (4 or less) then the course is cancelled/rescheduled.

- RYA HQ will inform all parties of the cancellation/rescheduling.

RACING COACH COURSE

Post course.

Pass, Not There Yet (Action Plan) (complete within 6 months), or Retake course at later date.

- Tutor will assist candidates who are Not There Yet, where necessary to complete their Action Plan.
