



## Zone Squad Application Process

Once you have applied for Zone squad, please make sure you attend all required selection events as stated in the relevant selection policy. You will need to enter the BYS Regional Junior Championships through the RYA racing events webpage and the regional event and Open training either through the class association webpage or the venue itself.

### Squad Application Information

- You can amend your application right up until the deadline
- If you are a double hander sailor please make sure both helm and crew apply separately and if selected, both need to accept their places and pay individually
- Selection notifications will go out within 14 days of the last selection event. Please check your junk email folders as the emails quite often end up there!
- If you are selected for a squad there are only a few days to accept and pay for your place. Zone Squad fees for this year can be found [here](#)
- The first squad session after place acceptance is the first weekend in November the Land Day – one day of Land based training for both the sailor and a parent
