

WELCOME TO OXFORD SAILING CLUB

We look forward to welcoming you to OSC and Farmoor Reservoir on 23/24 September 2017 for the RYA Zone Championships.

Thames Water own the club facilities and Farmoor Reservoir, allowing use by OSC under a lease. The Reservoir is a nature reserve and users include OSC members and visitors, Thames Water staff, fishermen, birdwatchers, walkers, other members of the public. To help us to run the event smoothly and to respect the needs of all users of the Reservoir may we please ask you to observe the following:

Parking/Unloading Boats

If possible, please unload all boats in the car park and bring them up the slip road to the launching area. If cars do need to be taken up to the club please observe the strict 10 minute rule (ie car and trailer must be returned to the car park within 10 minutes). Roadways and footpaths around the clubhouse must be kept clear at all times to allow people/cars/boats to move freely around the site.

If you are attending a weekend event, please park all boats neatly on Saturday evening using the grassed area on the right hand side of the clubhouse (when facing the Reservoir).

All boats and trailers are left unattended at the owner's risk.

Dogs are permitted in the car park and on the Countryside walk which is accessible from the car park near the toilet block, but they are not allowed on the rest of the site.

Vehicles are not allowed to be left on site overnight this includes camper-vans. There are however locations nearby where camper-vans and camping can be accommodated details can be found on our website.

Thames Water make a charge of £2 to exit the car park, so please ensure you have a supply of coins.

The Clubhouse and Changing

Please note the separate wet and dry seating areas in the club house.

Space is rather limited in the changing rooms. Please use hot water sparingly and try to keep the changing rooms tidy. Please note that there have recently been a series of thefts from the changing rooms.

Catering

We are fortunate to have Hackett's providing catering. They will be open all day providing hot drinks, breakfasts and snacks on arrival and a hot meal after racing. Lunches will be available for visitors who are not sailing. Please help Hackett's by tidying up after yourselves, returning crockery and cutlery to the table in front of the kitchen.
