

## RYA London & South East regional Junior Championships 2019 Arrival Instructions

28<sup>th</sup>/29<sup>th</sup> September 2019



### Arrival

When entering the Club, please proceed up to the Roller-blockade and wait for the traffic light signal to turn green. It is very important that one vehicle passes the roller-blockade at a time and no cars "tail-gate" the vehicle in front, otherwise severe damage will occur.

Once past the gate, please proceed to the left-hand ramp to the drop-off point following the one-way system. When approaching the top of the "up" ramp and drop-off point, please follow the directions of the marshals and drop-off all boats and equipment into the boat set-up area.

A strict drop off rule will apply and those with trailers encouraged to un-couple and drive away immediately. To allow other sailors to drop-off their boats, please can all parents / car drivers move all vehicles back down the "down" ramp and park in the car park.

Box boat trailers can be stored in the boat park area; those with road trailers should park them in the car park area.

RIB drivers are invited to drop off their trailers in the RIB parking area (to the south of the Club) and take their vehicle back to the parking area. The Club will provide a launching vehicle to assist with launching.

There are easy-access steps up to the Club house from the car park.

## **Marshals**

Site marshals will be positioned around the site to direct vehicles, sailors and boats. We ask all sailors and parents taking part in the event to respect the marshal's directions and instructions.

## **Catering Facilities (Cash Only)**

Full catering facilities are available all day on Saturday and Sunday for meals, snacks, sandwiches, hot and cold drinks. There is also a licensed bar available in the Club house. Sailors wishing to bring their own packed lunches can use the outside benches. All catering facilities are available in the "wet bar" allowing sailors to enter the Club house in wet clothing. (Cash Only)

## **Changing Facilities**

Both male and female changing rooms and hot showers are available for all sailors. All users of the changing rooms are advised not to leave any valuable items unattended.

## **Camping Facilities**

Datchet Water Sailing Club has a large open area suitable for tent and vehicle camping on site. Camping is only available on Saturday night. There is no hook up facilities at DWSC.

## **Site Rules**

No dogs on site.

No access around the reservoir outside the club boundaries

Buoyancy aids must be worn on the beach and pontoons at all times.

Clean wash dry is in effect please see signs

No one will be permitted onto the steep part of the beach unless wearing a life jacket. Parents and supporters are encouraged to bring waders to assist on the two slipways.

## **Exiting the Club**

All vehicles leaving the Club must obtain an "events pass" from the Club house to activate the roller-blocker barrier. Please ensure you have collected your pass before leaving the car park, otherwise you will not be able to pass the barrier.

The barrier may be dropped to allow you to leave without an event pass. Please check at reception when you leave.
